



Chris Miller TYO Music Director, Symphony Conductor

Christopher Miller has been Music Director of Tallahassee Youth Orchestras since 2017. He previously served as Associate Music Director and Chamber Orchestra Director from 2007 to 2017. Mr. Miller is also the Director of Orchestras at Lawton Chiles High School, where he directs three orchestras in addition to teaching A.P. Music Theory and Advanced Guitar. Under his direction. orchestras from Chiles have placed first (2009) and third (2014) at the National Orchestra Festival and first place in Festival Disney (2011).



Mr. Miller served in various capacities as a member of the Florida Orchestra Association, including 5 years as District Chair. He was a member of the Tallahassee Symphony for over 20 years, the majority of them as principal second violin. His degrees include a BA in American Studies and Master of Music Education from Florida State University. He also holds a BM in violin performance from DePaul University, where he was a student of Chicago Symphony Co-Concertmaster Victor Aitay. Miller achieved National Board Certification in 2005, the same year he received the Wiley Housewright Award for Excellence in Music Education. In 2010 he was selected by the American String Teachers Association as Florida Outstanding School Teacher.

Dr. Kasia Bugaj, Chamber Orchestra Director

Kasia Bugaj is an Associate Professor of Music Education at The Florida State University, where she helps prepare future music educators to work with orchestras and string students. In addition to teaching college students during the academic year Dr. Bugaj enjoys working with young musicians at the FSU Summer Music Camps. Prior to her appointment at Florida State University, Dr. Bugaj was the director of the Attica Violin Project, in Attica, Indiana.



Dr. Bugaj was the assistant director of the Fairview and Highland Park string programs in Bloomington, IN, and taught violin and viola on the faculty of the Indiana University String Academy. She also taught violin and viola at Valparaiso University, was a member of the viola section with the Kalamazoo Symphony Orchestra, and also played with the Grand Rapids and Louisville Symphony Orchestras. She received her Ph.D. in Music Education from Indiana University Jacobs School of Music. She also has degrees from Western Michigan University, The Peabody Conservatory, and is a graduate of the Interlochen Arts Academy (which is a truly magical place and the reason she decided to become a musician).



Ashley Hagadorn-Brien, Primo and Intermezzo Strings Director

Violist, violinist, conductor, and educator Ashley Hagadorn-Brien was raised in South Florida. She is a Florida State University graduate, earning a Bachelors in Music Education and Viola Performance Certificate in 2012. She has previously served as Orchestra Director at

Montford Middle School and Cobb Middle School, as well as the inaugural Orchestra Director at Lincoln High School. As a member of the Florida Orchestra Association, she has judged many events across the state. Mrs. Hagadorn-Brien currently performs with several orchestras in the Tri-State area and in local events, and maintains a private studio. She volunteers with local public school orchestra programs, serves as a chamber music instructor for Tallahassee Homeschool String Orchestra, and is the viola coach for the Javacya Conservatory's Elite Chamber Orchestra. Mrs. Hagadorn-Brien is excited to be serving in her 10th season with the TYO!
